

Fall Camp & 2026 Program FAQ

Q: Why is Fall Camp canceled this year?

A: Fall Camp is not taking place due to ongoing financial challenges. At this time, we are unable to operate the fall session in a way that meets our standards for safety, staffing, and program quality.

Q: Was this decision avoidable?

A: We explored multiple options but ultimately could not find a financially sustainable way to run the fall program. The decision was made carefully and thoughtfully.

Q: Will Fall Camp return in future years?

A: Our goal is to bring back all camp programs once we achieve financial stability. While we cannot guarantee a future fall session yet, we are actively working toward long-term sustainability.

Q: Why is the registration fee increasing to \$500?

A: Rising operational costs—including staffing, supplies, facilities, and safety requirements—have made it necessary to adjust our fees. The increase helps ensure we can continue providing a high-quality program for our campers.
